Dear Families:

Welcome to Bridges Nursery School & Kindergarten. We are proud to have you join our school family. All forms regarding your child's upcoming year are posted on this website. Please click on [forms](#) to download any of the following:

- Calendar, Parent Orientation Meeting, Tuition Payment Schedule, Medical, and (if necessary) Allergy Treatment Plan
- The medical form must be filled out and signed by your physician. (Medical forms apply to all Kindergarten and any new students only.) Yellow cards (available only at school) can be completed by parents as well as physicians.
- An "Allergy Treatment Plan" signed by your physician must be brought to the school if your child has any allergies that will require special treatment. Doctor's Orders must accompany the plan if an Epi-pen and or antihistamine are being provided to the school. Epi-pens and antihistamines must be in their unopened, original containers with a separate prescription sticker adhered to each of them.
- Yearly Influenza vaccines are mandatory. When your child receives the inoculation, a letter must be provided by the doctor. Flu shots are usually given between October and February and must be given each year.
- Completed papers for all students are due no later than August 1st. No child is permitted to begin school without all of the required paperwork completed and returned to me. Do not bring paperwork to school the night of the parent meeting.
- Tuition payment # 2 is due on or before August 1st. (This does not apply to students who have prepaid or are not starting school in September.)
- Tuition payment #3 is due October 1st.

Your expediency in this matter is greatly appreciated and allows me more time to create a smooth transition for all students and their families. "I'll never get a second chance to make a first impression."
