



Dear Families:

On **Thursday, October 27th** and **Friday, October 28th** we will be celebrating Halloween in school! Kindergarten will celebrate on Friday, October 28th. These are regular school days with regular hours. Your child may wear his/her costume, but please be sure it is comfortable enough to wear for the day, safe enough to move in, and designed with adequate visibility. In addition to a class party, we will also have a Halloween parade. Your cooperation is of the utmost importance since we will be parading inside. I ask that you be prepared to stay in school for approximately 15 minutes after you drop your child off. Please assemble in the gym and stand in the middle, the children will be walking the white line around the perimeter of the gymnasium. All cameras are welcome! **DO NOT REMOVE YOUR CHILD FROM HIS/HER LINE BECAUSE WE WILL BE GOING BACK TO OUR CLASSROOM TO BEGIN OUR DAY WHEN THE PARADE IS FINISHED.** I would also appreciate it if you do not stand outside the classrooms or in the foyer, as we need as much space as possible for the children to walk safely through the hallway. Please understand that Halloween can be frightening for some children and your patience is greatly appreciated. Thank you in advance for your cooperation!
